Fundraising toolkit

The toolkit will provide you with lots of hints and tips on the kind of activities that you could organise, as well as some handy steps to take to ensure your fundraising is a success!

Lanyard and badge

This lets everyone know that you're a member of #TheCrew. Don't forget to wear it when you're hosting an event, or activity. Your membership number is unique to you, make sure you quote it when paying in your fundraising money so we know it's come from you!



Certificate

This certifies that you are a member of #TheCrew! You can display it at home or put it somewhere safe.

Template posters

You can use these to promote your activity. Write the name of the activity, date, time and any prices (if appropriate) and put them up around your school or local community (remember to ask permission first). Stickers

Use these to decorate your posters or give them to people if they make a donation or buy something from your event. If you need more, just email us and we'll send you some.
